

Wilderness Skills Pack Trip

Packing List

NOTE: Because their gear must be packed on a mule, the allowed items are quite limited. Please limit all items (except sleeping bag) to a duffel bag of no more than 16x12x10. We have appropriate sized bags in our Lodge store. If you would like to purchase one to pack in, please contact us.

<p>Cowboy Boots Comfortable sneakers or hiking boots Jeans for riding T-shirts, socks, underwear At least 1 long sleeved shirt Warm Pajamas Warm jacket (<i>fleece, wool blend or sweatshirt</i>) Sleeping Bag & SMALL pillow Hand soap, shampoo, toothbrush & toothpaste Towel and washcloth Waterproof jacket or poncho Hat (baseball, sun hat or cowboy hat) Prescription medication Water bottle or canteen (should hold at least 24-36 ounces) Small backpack</p>	<p>Shorts Sunglasses, sunscreen and Chap Stick Bug spray (<i>bring what you are accustomed to!</i>) Headlamp or Flashlight (<i>small and light with new batteries</i>) Camera A good book or journal 1-2 Photographs of family and friends Gloves Trail snacks (<i>please let us know if camper brings any food</i>) Pocket Knife (<i>to be given to trip leaders, who will return to boys at appropriate times</i>) Compass Survival Kit (<i>leaders will be discussing these and what is really useful. If you have one, you may bring it for evaluation.</i>)</p>

Note about allergies: If your camper has specific food related allergies, please inform us in advance of his arrival at camp. Also please consider sending him with some appropriate snack food that he likes for his trip (i.e. nut free trail mix).

Note about Clothing: Clothing for both warm and cold weather conditions is necessary since weather can, and often does, change quickly. Please assist with your camper's packing, in order to ensure needed items get packed. Please mark all articles of clothing and belongings with your camper's name.

Riding Helmets: Camp has a supply of riding helmets if you do not own one. All campers are required to wear a helmet when riding, unless their parent signs a waiver.
